

## Requirements for a Marriage License Issued by Dawson County

1. Both applicants must supply a valid form of photo identification. (Example: Drivers license or passport).
2. Applicants must supply their social security number, if a number has been issued to them. (In the event applicant has no social security number, affidavit must be signed stating they do not possess one).
3. If either applicant is not of legal age (19), a consent form must be signed by a parent or guardian and notarized. Applicants must be 17 years of age at the time of marriage. You cannot marry in Nebraska if you are under 17.
4. Need to know birthplace of Party A and Party B.
5. Applicants must supply the full names and birthplaces of both parents (including mother's maiden name).
6. If an applicant has been divorced, we need to know the date of divorce decree.
7. Both applicants must appear together at the County Clerk's office between 8 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. on weekdays.
8. The fee for a marriage license is \$25.00, either cash or check.
9. Marriage license is valid for one year from date of issuance, and there is not a waiting period.
10. A couple may apply for their license in any county in Nebraska and use it to be married in any other Nebraska county.
